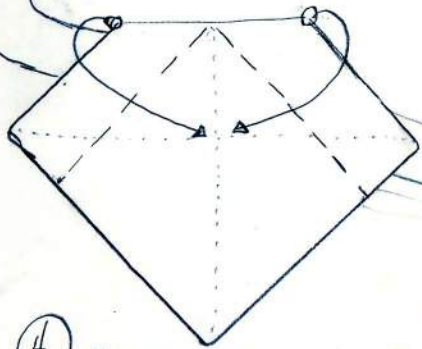
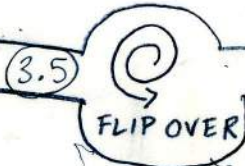
1. FOLD ALONG

& OPEN



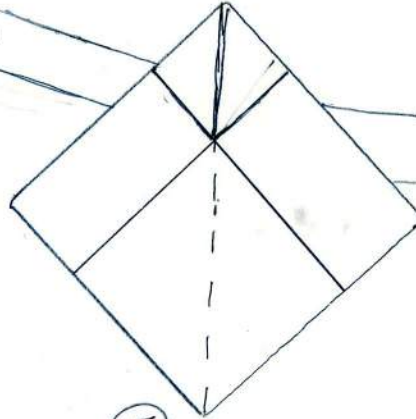
2. REPEAT ON

CENTER.



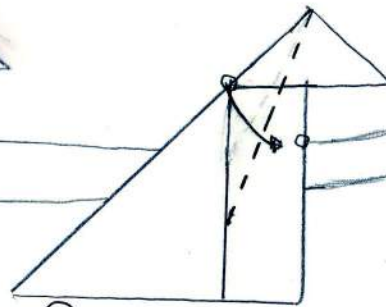
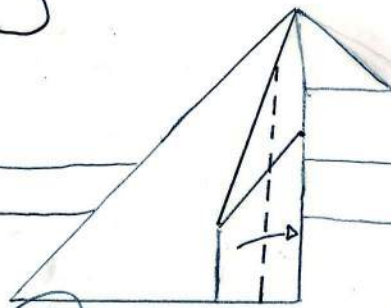
4. FOLD SIDES

SIDES

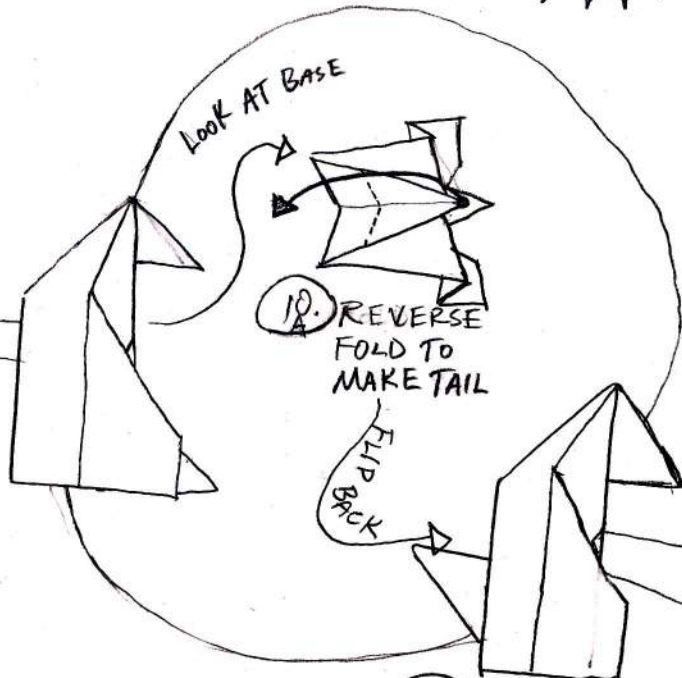
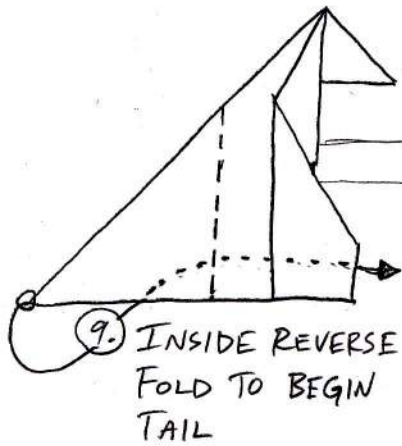
